Death and Burial information from 1957 Dixon/Dickson Book by John Sherman Dickson

It is likely that Charles, his two brothers and his father John migrated from the Moravian conclaves around Salem to Burke Co NC in the 1825-1830 period. Census, tax and land records place the brothers there; Charles first marriage to Elizabeth Bradshaw took place in 1830, and John died in 1832 and was buried there. The families were mostly settled in McDowell Co in Dysartsville, which was near the center of a gold mining boom, which was the likely draw to the area. All of Charles' 7 children from his union to Elizabeth Bradshaw were born there, as were others. By pre-civil war years several of the sons had moved on to Arkansas and the remainder of the families migrated to South Carolina or other North Carolina areas.

There is anecdotal evidence that his name was Charles William Marion Dickson.[William Dixon 10-22-2006.FTW]
