In the 1957 "Little Blue Book" By Cousin John Sherman Dixon/Dickson Family
John Sherman Stated John Dixon Married ..Maria Blum.
I have researched several years and cannot find any Marriage record for John and Maria Blum.
2000 after much research on the Computer and at Stokes, Surry and other County records in North Carolina neither myself or cousin Carolyn Owen have been able to validate any marriage for John Dixon to Maria Blum.
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*Now on to Johann Dixon being ask to leave the church....  
Since the Moravians were So strict with their beliefs.....I could not understand  
if Johann Dixon was not a member of the Moravian church why /how  
could /would they allow the 3rd son George Christian Dixon born April 7, 1812  
to be baptized and be listed in the Moravian diary.*

*This was the reply from the archives.....(my mind is still not settled that this is  
all of the story. I will let you know what I learn to add to this research.)*

*From Salem Moravian Archives:*

*According to the minutes of the Aulseher Collegium (Financial Board) dated January 23, 1810, John Dixon was  
notified of the expiration of his lease and was expelled from Salem. He and his family moved, we have no record as  
to where though the indication would be they moved outside of Friedberg since they had a child by the name of  
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*January 23, 1810 JOHN DIXON was expelled from the Moravian Church by the board, "John Dixon of whoes bad  
habits they do not approve of. He moved to the Friedlnd area.*

*At one time he was living with his sister, Elizabeth and Bro in law Rev. Martin Schneider.*

*The youngest son of John, George Christian, was born 1812 and Baptised at Friedland.*

*Typed as the report reads..... ( Copy from Salem Moravian Archives in Personal Files of Betty Green)*

*12 Sept 1809 "there was a loud complaint about the disorderly household John Dixon is leading in our  
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*Spring 2000 Carolyn Owen gave me the first indication that our John Dixon died in Burke county and was buried
in Mount Home Baptist Church Cemetery. I had NO Validation*

*to back up this information personally searched the Cemetery shortly after speaking with Carolyn and I DID NOT
see a stone....many stones I could not read.*

*I had written the Church and was told their files were in a safe deposit box...and at some time ??? they could look
at them...well 18 months pasted and I heard nothing.*

*Cousin Joyce Waters contacted the secretary of the church still nothing.....finally ...about 4 months 2003 ago I
spoke with the secretary again...and was told that yes they Had a "John Dixon" buried in the cemetery .. but that is
ALL the information she had...*

*So I contacted NC Archives in Raleigh.. gave them the info I had and paid for them to research for me/us....below
is their reply.*

October 2003

Dear Betty,

*You are right! I looked in the WPA card index and it is there! Mount Home Baptist Church cemetery 4 miles
southeast of Morganton. John Dixon born December 23,1763 died March 1832. Broken stone. This is earliest
marked stone in cemetery.*

*When WPA surveyed cemetery about 1939,there were 151 marked graves and 75 unmarked. I looked at this
cemetery list both on WPA microfilm and in Burke County cemetery books,there was no other Dixon or Poteet.

It is likely that Charles, his two brothers and his father John migrated from the Moravian conclaves around Salem to Burke Co NC in the 1825-1830 period. Census, tax and land records place the brothers there; Charles first marriage to Elizabeth Bradshaw took place in 1830, and John died in 1832 and was buried there. The families were mostly settled in McDowell Co in Dysartsville, which was near the center of a gold mining boom, which was the likely draw to the area. All of Charles' 7 children from his union to Elizabeth Bradshaw were born there, as were others. By pre-civil war years several of the sons had moved on to Arkansas and the remainder of the families migrated to South Carolina or other North Carolina areas.

There is anecdotal evidence that his name was Charles William Marion Dickson. [William Dixon 10-22-2006.FTW]
