*I, Betty Green have personally validated that George C. Dixon served in CSA Company I ...18 Reg. NC Died from pneumonia in Richmond hospital December 15,1862.*

*Copy of CSA records in file of Betty Green*

*Letter written from George to wife Martha and Martha's Claim for Widows pension are also in my file.*

*He enlisted CSA Aug 17,1862,shown on several service cards. One service card shows enlisted Sept. 10,1862.*

*Different service cards show different dates of death,such as Dec 15,1862 Dec 16,1862 Dec 25,1862 Dec 30,1862 Jan 6,1863. Admitted to hospital Dec 6,1862. He was last paid November 1,1862. His widow was given \$20.16 for pay between November 1,1862 and December 15,1862.*

*I have a brief history of 18th NC Regiment. It shows on Sept 5,1862 crossed Potomac River from VA to MD. On Sept 9,1862 ordered to move towards Harpers Ferry. So Sept 8,1862 in Frederick,MD makes sense. since this is where the letter I have in my file states he was Sept 08 1862, Between Nov 26,1862 and Dec 11,1862 in Fredericksburg,VA area. This must be when George became sick and sent to hospital in Richmond. That is where my research shows he died from pneumonia.*
