Different service cards show different dates of death, such as Dec 15,1862 Dec 16,1862 Dec 25,1862 Dec 30,1862 Jan 6,1863. Admitted to hospital Dec 6,1862. He was last paid November 1,1862. His widow was given \$20.16 for pay between November 1,1862 and December 15,1862.

I have a brief history of 18th NC Regiment. It shows on Sept 5,1862 crossed Potomac River from VA to MD. On Sept 9,1862 ordered to move towards Harpers Ferry.
